

Purler Wrestling, Inc.
Athletic Camp Agreement

The undersigned parent(s) or guardian(s), in consideration of the applicant's ("athlete") acceptance and participation in the Purler Wrestling, Inc. ("Purler") wrestling and athletic camp ("camp"), hereby agrees as follows:

Assumption of Risks & Participation

I am aware of the dangers involved for the athlete in the camp. I acknowledge that participating in the camp involves known and unanticipated risks which could result in physical or emotional injury, paralysis or permanent disability, death, and property damage. Risks include, but are not limited to: broken bones, torn ligaments or other injuries as a result of falls or contact with other athletes or camp staff. I understand such risks simply cannot be eliminated, despite the use of safety equipment, without jeopardizing the essential qualities of the activity. I represent that the athlete has adequate insurance to cover any injury or damage the athlete may suffer or cause while participating in camp activities, or else I agree to bear the costs of such injury or damage myself. I further represent that the athlete has no medical or physical conditions which could interfere with his or her safety in these activities, or I am willing to assume "and bear the costs of " all risks that may be created, directly or indirectly, by any such condition.

I am aware that activities related to the camp may involve the use of certain equipment. I am aware that such equipment in no way guarantees the athlete's safety from injury. Additionally, said equipment must be used in a proper manner. The athlete will follow all instructions related to camp activities and the use of equipment including those instructions provided by the manufacturer and camp staff.

The athlete's participation in camp activities is a voluntary act with full and complete knowledge of the risks involved. On my behalf, my individual family members, and on behalf of the athlete, and our respective heirs, assigns and personal representatives, I assume all risks associated with the athlete's participation in camp activities.

Medical Treatment Authorization:

I represent that the athlete has been examined by a physician in the last year and is in good health. I hereby authorize Purler and camp staff to act for me, according to its, his or her best judgment in any medical emergency, and I hereby waive and release Purler and camp staff from any liability for injuries, illness, or skin infections incurred by the athlete while attending camp. Coaching staff will treat minor injuries typical to athletic participation. I understand there is no trainer/physician present at camp.

Athlete Expectation Information:

Purler is proud to sponsor the camp. In order to ensure that each athlete's experience is safe and enjoyable, all athletes are asked to abide by a strict code of conduct. Lack of adherence to this agreement may lead to expulsion of the athlete from camp.

The athlete agrees that he or she will:

- Participate and cooperate in all camp activities (including camp meals).
- Respect all safety guidelines required by Purler and camp staff.
- Follow the camp schedule, including curfew, wake-up and lights-out policies.
- Wear appropriate clothing and shoes during all activities.
- Be responsible for his or her valuables. Purler is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Notify camp staff whenever a problem arises, whether big or small.

- Abide by all camp rules and policies, as well as all federal/state laws.

The athlete agrees that he or she will not:

- Use profanity or inappropriate language, whether it is written or verbal.
- Allow unapproved visitors into the dormitory or dining areas.
- Possess and/or use alcohol, tobacco, or illegal substances.
- Possess matches, lighters, hot plates, fireworks, weapons, or other objects that Purler or camp staff may deem dangerous.
- Possess and/or distribute indecent literature or images.
- Tamper with fire alarms, sprinkler systems or other safety or security equipment.
- Damage or steal Purler or other people's property.
- Harass, bully, or intimidate other athletes or staff.
- Engage in excessive noisemaking or horseplay.
- Have romantic relationships with camp staff or other athletes.
- Sleep in any quarters other than the one assigned.

To ensure that everyone has a positive experience while participating at camp, athletes are expected to behave in a disciplined, responsible, and respectful manner at all times, whether on or off the Purler facilities. Failure to follow these rules and regulations may subject the athletes to immediate disciplinary action including possible dismissal from camp. **Refunds will NOT be given for any athletes dismissed or expelled from camp for failing to follow the terms of this agreement.**

Photo & Video Authorization:

I hereby consent to and authorize the use and reproduction, in print or electronic format by Purler of any and all photographs which have been taken of the athlete for any publicity purpose without compensation. All electronic images, together with the prints, are owned by Purler.

I authorize Purler to make pictures and sound recordings of the athlete and use the same in any form for its purposes and consent that the pictures and recordings may be copied, published, telecast or broadcast for such purposes together with descriptions and editorial statements. Purler is not responsible for third party photographs.

Policy on the Responsible Use of Mobile Phones and Digital Devices:

Mobile phones should be used solely in accordance with this agreement. Athletes are permitted to bring mobile phones to camp, but their use is subject to the following terms and conditions. The term "phone" in this policy denotes mobile phones, tablets, laptops and other portable electronic devices.

Athletes are required to use phones responsibly at all times.

- An athlete must not store files on his or her phones or transmit files that contain violent, degrading or offensive images.
- Cyber-bullying is completely unacceptable.
- Mobile phones must not be used in camp sessions, unless camp staff gives permission, for example to listen to music when deemed appropriate. Phones should remain switched off and out of sight and should not be used to contact another person via texting or ringing.
- Responsibility for a phone rests with the athlete; Purler accepts no financial responsibility for loss, damage or theft. Purler has no personal liability insurance for athletes.

- Phones must not be used under any circumstances to photograph or video other athletes or camp staff. Any athlete using his or her phone to take photographs or videos may have his or her phone confiscated. The athlete will be expected to delete images and videos from his or her phone and any associated postings on the Internet, including YouTube, upon request of Purler or camp staff.

Quarters:

At the discretion of Purler, any damages to the camp quarters or other facilities may be the responsibility of the athlete.

Release, Waiver and Indemnity,:

I agree to release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue Purler and the camp and their respective owners, officers, directors, employees, staff, volunteers and agents (the "Releasees") from any and all liability, claims, demands, actions and causes of action whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, damage or injury, including death (each, a "Loss"), that may be sustained by me or the athlete or to any property belonging to any of us, while participating in camp activities or while at the Purler facilities or the camp, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER SUCH LOSS IS CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF ANY OF THE RELEASEES or otherwise, and regardless of whether such liability arises in tort, contract, strict liability or otherwise, to the fullest extent allowed by law.

I further agree to exonerate, save, indemnify, and hold harmless the Releasees from any and all Losses of any kind and nature whatsoever which may arise from or in connection with the athlete's conduct at the camp and his or her participation in any camp activities including, without limitation, personal injury, and any breach of this agreement by me or the athlete.

It is my express intent that this agreement shall bind the members of my family and spouse, if any, and my heirs, assigns and personal representatives and shall be deemed as a release, waiver, discharge and covenant not to sue the above-named Releasees.

In signing this agreement, I acknowledge and represent that I have read this agreement, understand it and sign it voluntarily as my own free act and deed, I am at least eighteen years of age and fully competent, and I execute this agreement for full, adequate and complete consideration fully intending to be bound by the same. Further, I have reviewed this agreement with the athlete and he or she fully understands and agrees to follow all of the terms of this agreement while attending Purler camp. All information I have provided to Purler in the camp application or otherwise is accurate and complete.
